

This month's presentation by Christine Morrissey, director of East Bay Animal Advocates, will examine how Californians impact the lives of humans and animals, and the environment, every time a meat or dairy product is purchased.

Morrissey has conducted investigative rescues at egg, turkey, dairy and broiler farms in California's Central Valley. Attendees will get the opportunity to observe the unfiltered plight of animals in the agriculture. EBAA's Free Range and Dairy Investigations will be examined in detail.

Morrisey works full-time as the Outreach Coordinator for the Contra Costa County Bar Association, where she organizes free animal law legal clinics, and is a humane officer in California.
